Ditem Consolidates Second Largest Uranium Land Package in Otish Mountains After Cameco

MONTREAL, QUEBEC--(CCNMatthews - June 7, 2006) - Ditem Explorations Inc. (TSX VENTURE:DIT - News; "Ditem") is pleased to announce that it has applied for, and expects to shortly receive, exploration permits to claims in north-central Quebec's Otish Mountains covering 210 km², adding to the company's already significant longstanding land position in the area, and establishing Ditem as a leading participant in the Otish Mountain uranium play. Ditem will now hold one contiguous block of approximately 340 km².

The area covered falls within a prominent geological environment considered highly favourable for uranium exploration. The property obtained is directly adjacent to the Matoush Property originally drilled by Uranerz Exploration in 1984, which returned grades of 0.95% of U₃O₈ over 16 meters at a depth of 220 metres. The property was recently re-drilled by Strateco which has reported grades of 1.54% of U₃O₈ over 9.5 metres at the same target site. The new claims are bordered to the south by Cameco and to the north and west by Ditem's Tichegami and Beaver Lake claims. On the north-western portion of the company's new claims, a property registered to UEM Inc. reported samples grading from 0.23% up to 2.46% of U₃O₈. Ditem President and CEO, Raymond Savoie, stated, "We have assembled a commanding land position in the Otish Mountains, one of Canada's most exciting areas for uranium exploration, and the site of several prospective and highly interesting targets, based on a more advanced understanding of the area's geology. Going forward, Ditem will be aggressively testing a well-formed geological theory and following up on a number of exciting targets, aimed at identifying a major deposit held within our substantial land package."

A 43-101 is currently being prepared and the organization of a work program is underway. The company plans to commence a drill program later this fall.

The Otish Mountains' similarity of uranium mineralization to Saskatchewan's Athabasca basin, and its considerable potential to host large high-grade uranium deposits has been recognized since the 1970's. At that time, several uranium occurrences were identified in the Proterozoic sediments of the Otish Group. The Beaver Lake and Matoush Lake occurrences lie along one of three east - west structures identified by regional airborne magnetic surveys, the majority of which are now held by Ditem. Ditem has been active in the area since the mid 1990s and has its own airborne magnetics (75 m. spacing) on large segments of the area.

Dr. Raymond Davies (P.Eng) is the designated Qualified Person responsible for the preparation of this release.

Ditem Explorations Inc. is intent on aggressively building shareholder value through the acquisition, exploration and development of high-quality projects. The company presently holds exploration properties in Quebec and the Athabasca Basin.

The company is in the process of putting together a comprehensive website to keep investors and interested parties abreast of corporate developments.
